Project Area: Boyle Heights/LANI Vest Pocket Park
Located at the northeast corner of First and Chicago Streets in Boyle Heights (See map below)

Project Funds: \$346,510

Project Summary: This project will substantially improve the quality-of-life in this neighborhood by creating an exceptional public space where transit and community intersect. Located in the heart of Boyle Heights' First Street civic, commercial, and transit district, the Boyle Heights/LANI Vest Pocket Park has been designated a "transit mall." This project will improve the transit environment, create a beautiful, accessible green space, and strengthen the appeal of local businesses to passing automobile drivers, thus enriching the local micro-economy as well as the daily lives of tens of thousands of residents and transit-users. Improvements to the park and surrounding area will be selected and approved by the community.
